

Every paper must be registered with a correct paper designator, which is a combination of the designator prefix and the paper id generated by EasyChair. For example, the designator of the IEEE CLOUD conference "regular paper" #1234 is "CLD_REG_1234". The prefix is "CLD_REG_".

FIGURING OUT YOUR PAPER DESIGNATOR

For the six main conferences, the 3-letter code based designator naming template is

ConfSymAcronym_PaperType_PaperNumber

ConfSymAcronym is specified as follows:

- CLD** - IEEE CLOUD 2024
- CDH** - IEEE ICDH 2024
- CWS** - IEEE ICWS 2024
- EDG** - IEEE EDGE 2024
- QSW** - IEEE QSW 2024
- SSE** - IEEE SSE 2024

PaperType is specified as follows:

- REG** - regular papers
- SHT** - short papers
- WIP** - work-in-progress papers
- CON** - invited papers

PaperNumber (#) is a 3 or 4 digit number generated by EasyChair, which may be reused in multiple EasyChair sites. For example, CLOUD and ICWS may both have paper #15. Hence, the prefix **ConfSymAcronym_PaperType_** must be correctly provided in author's registration and camera-ready, so that their paper can be identified as "Paid" and be placed into the correct conference proceeding in a timely manner.

To use ICWS as an example:

- ICWS regular paper: **CWS_REG_#** (# is **PaperNumber**)
- ICWS short paper: **CWS_SHT_#**
- ICWS WIP paper: **CWS_WIP_#**
- ICWS invited paper: **CWS_CON_#**

For symposia & workshops, their paper designators have been specified in the following table:
